



COVID-19 POLICIES

- All Shandon Weekday School Staff are vaccinated.
- A positive COVID exposure at Shandon Weekday School:
 - will not require any classmates or staff to enter quarantine, regardless of vaccination status or recent COVID infection (household exposure differs).
 - will require a negative test to be administered on day six to continue attending. This test should be labeled with the individual's name, test date, and test time, and it should be sent to SWS office administration.
- A positive COVID household exposure:
 - will require any Shandon-attending students or staff to enter a five-day quarantine period regardless of vaccination status or recent COVID infection.
 - will require a negative test to be administered on day six before a day six return from quarantine. This test should be labeled with the child's name, test date, and test time. If the household-exposed individual begins showing symptoms, additional testing will be required.
 - will require a restart of the timeline of the five-day quarantine. Any new household infection information should be sent to SWS Office administration.
- A positive COVID infection:
 - must enter a 10-day isolation period.
 - requires any siblings who attend Shandon to adhere to the Household Exposure policy. Any positive test results should be sent to SWS Office administration.
- Masking is optional at Shandon Weekday School.

These policies are subject to change and will remain in place as long as the Richland County rate of COVID infection remains classified as low or medium.
